	I have lived in Colwall for nearly 20 years.	

I understand that all areas are under pressure to develop, however, with the right planning and architectural merit I feel that most developments can enhance the area.

In the case of Colwall I feel that it would be very easy to build on all the fill in areas but at what cost. In our fairly short time of living here we have seen a number of footpaths become engulfed under concrete and a housing estate. This is a great pity because although the hills can easily be seen they seem to be getting further and further away.

I would like to see smaller developments and more in keeping with the current village housing – try not to make the developments three storey (I realise that this is more difficult now that the block of flats next door to the Colwall Park has three stories not two and a half as promised). I was disappointed to see that the Malvern Water site has built the nursing home three stories high. Perhaps if land becomes available people should be allowed to build affordable homes of their own (two or three per site perhaps) as long as they are in keeping with the village.

We should not be bullied by building firms or people within the village who feel they have influence and should be allowed to build what they like.

Villagers should be encouraged to have a say and to come out and vote – this could be done be email, going door to door or by putting up more poster in the village and making sure that adverts for the meeting in the papers etc. are done on a large scale – make it stand out, make people care.
